PLUMBER

DEFINITION

To perform journey level maintenance duties in the installation, maintenance, and repair of plumbing fixtures.

SUPERVISION RECEIVES AND EXERCISED

Receives general supervision from the Maintenance Supervisor.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES - Duties may include, but are not limited to, the following:

Installs, maintains, and repairs air, gas, water, waste, and steam lines, storm drains, steam drains, steam radiators, steam boilers, water heaters, forced air heaters, water coolers, circulating pumps, pumps on steam heating systems, disposal units, dishwashers, steam cookers, sinks and steam pressure regulators. Installs, maintains, and tests backflow devises. Maintains and cleans drains. Moves and installs heaters and plumbing fixtures. Maintains, repairs, and installs new water closets, lavatories, drinking fountains, showers, and other plumbing systems. Maintains an adequate supply of parts and fittings at all times. Performs related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge and Abilities: Knowledge of standard practices of plumbing installations, alteration and repair work. Knowledge of plumbing ordinances contained in applicable building codes. Ability to safely use the tools and equipment necessary in the repair and maintenance of plumbing installations. Ability to work from sketches or blueprints. Ability to maintain simple records. Ability to understand and carry out oral and written directions. Ability to work effectively in the absence of supervision. Ability to establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with those contacted in the course of work.

<u>Experience and Training Guidelines</u>: Any combination of experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and abilities would be:

Two years of increasingly responsible plumbing experience.
<u>Training</u> :
Formal or informal training which provides the ability to read and write at a level necessary for job performance supplemented by specialized training in plumbing.

Possession of, or ability to obtain, an appropriate, valid California driver's license.
Possession of, or ability to obtain, an appropriate, valid Backflow Certificate may be required for some positions.
