SWIMMING POOL MECHANIC

DEFINITION

To maintain the District's swimming pools in optimum operating and sanitary condition; to maintain and repair the heating, filtration, and other water circulation systems; and to do related work as required.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED AND EXERCISED

Receives general supervision from the Maintenance Supervisor.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES - Duties may include, but are not limited to, the following:

Maintains, adjusts, or repairs pumps, valves, filters, chlorinators, cogeneration systems, mercury manometers and water flow meters; tests chlorine, ph and temperature levels of pools. Adds chemicals and adjusts equipment and controls to maintain proper levels. Disconnects used chlorine cylinders and makes connections to full cylinders. Maintains daily log of water tests of pool operation. Requisitions supplies and materials. Dusts, sweeps, and cleans the pool filter and equipment room. Performs minor plumbing maintenance to pools as directed. Washes down pool decks daily or as needed. Cleans tile around edge of pools. Uses aqualung apparatus to scrub rust stains, algae, etc. Performs backwash procedures when needed. Performs related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge and Abilities: Knowledge of county and state health codes and regulations pertaining to the operation, servicing, and sanitation of public swimming pools. Knowledge of safety procedures related to pool operation and maintenance. Knowledge of equipment, chemicals, and tests used to maintain specified chlorination level, ph balance, temperature and purity of swimming pool water. Ability to operate and adjust swimming pool equipment in accordance with water tests and pool usage. Ability to make inspections of District pools for compliance with established health and operational standards, and to detect need for maintenance or repair of pool equipment. Ability to maintain simple records. Ability to understand and carry out oral and written directions. Ability to work effectively in the absence of super-vision. Ability to establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with those contacted in the course of work.

QUALIFICATIONS (Continued)

Experience and Training Guidelines: Any combination of experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and abilities would be:

Experience:

Two years of increasingly responsible large capacity swimming pool maintenance experience.

Training:

Formal or informal training which provides the ability to read and write at a level necessary for job performance supplemented by specialized training in swimming pool maintenance.

License or Certificate

Possession of, or ability to obtain, an appropriate, valid California driver's license.
