Carrie Buck has served as a member of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District Board of Education since 2010 and also currently serves as the Vice President of the Orange County School Board Association. She earned her Bachelor of Arts degree in Human Services from California State University, Fullerton. Prior to her election to the Board, she worked as an instructional assistant in special education for the District. She became involved in her children's schools through serving on the PTA and School Site Council, and as the school's representative to the Superintendent's Community Advisory Council. Carrie has three daughters, one who graduated from PYLUSD and two children currently attending PYLUSD schools.

Carrie is also the Executive Director of HIS House Homeless Intervention Shelter in Placentia and the owner of My Flippin' Party, event photography service. HIS House supports families and individuals to overcome homelessness and achieve independence. She also leads the Placentia Collaborative meetings each month that unite local community efforts in order to cultivate strong and healthy neighborhoods.

Carrie Buck works with leaders in education and homelessness to make a difference for people who do not have a strong voice in Orange County. In 2016, she was nominated for Something More's Woman of the Year award. In 2018, HIS House was named the Placentia Chamber of Commerce Nonprofit of the Year and recognized as the California 29th Senate District non-profit of the month in October 2019.
