The District and the City will cooperatively determine the District's fair share contribution to these improvements based upon the vehicle trips attributable to the proposed parking lot. (2) The District shall reimburse all expenses reasonably necessary for the City to prepare plans for and complete the re-striping of Madison Avenue between Kraemer Boulevard and Bradford Avenue to provide a left turn lane. Reimbursement shall be made upon completion of said improvements. (3) Prior to completing the access driveway from the project site on to Madison Avenue the District shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Placentia Traffic Engineer that the driveway will not interfere with the existing cross gutter on Madison Avenue. (4) Prior to the start of grading for the proposed project, the District shall coordinate with the Placentia City Engineer to implement the requested standard plan changes as identified in the City's letter of August 25, 2003.
