STUDENT TRANSITIONING INTO VALADEZ MIDDLE SCHOOL

2006-2007 School Year

Beginning in the 2006-2007 school year, K-4 students residing in the “Pocket Area” (Grids 441 and 443) now attending Tynes Elementary will attend Melrose Elementary. Fifth-grade students living in the “Pocket Area” may attend Melrose Elementary or attend Tynes Elementary for one year before promoting to Gualberto J. Valadez Middle School with transportation provided. Sixth-grade students living in the “Pocket Area” will continue to attend Tynes Elementary School with transportation provided.

2007-2008 School Year

- Students entering eighth grade shall remain at Kraemer Middle School for their final year of attendance. District transportation will continue to be provided to these students for one year.
- Students enrolled in Grades 6-7 and residing in the Gualberto J. Valadez Middle School attendance area shall attend Gualberto J. Valadez Middle School at the beginning of year one. Transfer requests will be considered in accordance with district policy.
- Siblings will be afforded grandfathering (exempt from new regulations) provisions provided they are concurrently in attendance with an older brother or sister in the original school of attendance (Kraemer/Tynes). District transportation will continue to be provided to these students for one year.

2008-2009 and Following

Students enrolled in Grades 6-8 and residing in the Gualberto J. Valadez Middle School attendance area shall attend Gualberto J. Valadez Middle School at the beginning of the 2008-2009 school year. Transfer requests will be considered in accordance with district policy.
