BOARD REPORT

1. Mrs. Karin Freeman indicated that the Valadez Middle School groundbreaking ceremony was a very meaningful occasion. With regard to her participation in the California School Boards Association (CSBA) Annual Conference, Mrs. Freeman indicated she attended workshop sessions on ROP offerings and Professional Development Academies. Mrs. Freeman expressed appreciation for her time as President of the Board and extended best wishes to incoming President Jan Wagner.
2. Dr. Craig Olson extended appreciation to Mrs. Karin Freeman for her leadership as President of the Board. He then indicated he attended a Delegate Assembly luncheon at the CSBA conference featuring the Chancellor of the California State University system. The Chancellor provided information relative to California State University's emphasis on reaching out to middle and high school students and the CSU policy of accepting all qualified students who apply.
