**RESOLUTION NO. 1**

**RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ACTING AS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1 AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF SPECIAL TAXES FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (the "Board") has heretofore taken proceedings pursuant to the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982, as amended, (the "Act") for the establishment of Community Facilities District No. 1 (the "District") for the purpose of providing educational facilities for the use of residents of the District; and

**WHEREAS**, following a special election of the qualified electors of the District, this Board on November 12, 2002 acting as the governing body of the District, adopted Ordinance No. 1 ("Ordinance") which provided for the levying and collection of Special Taxes within the District, "as provided in the Act and Ordinance and as approved by the qualified electors"; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary and appropriate that this Board levy and collect the Special Taxes for Fiscal Year 2009-2010, by the adoption of a resolution as specified by the Act and Ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. In accordance with the Act and Ordinance, there is hereby levied upon all properties within the District which are not otherwise exempt from taxation under the Act or Ordinance the special taxes for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 set forth in the Ordinance at the tax rates as set forth therein and in Exhibit "A" hereto, as may be amended without further action of the Board to reflect updated information on assessor's parcel numbers from the County of Orange. The Assistant Superintendent, Administrative Services, is hereby authorized and directed to establish the final rates to be levied, which final rates shall not exceed the maximum rates.

Section 2. The above-authorized special taxes shall be collected in the same manner as ad valorem property taxes on the secured roll by the Treasurer-Tax Collector of the County of Orange and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedure and sale in cases of delinquency as provided for such ad valorem taxes.

Section 3. The Clerk and Assistant Superintendent, Administrative Services, are hereby authorized to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Orange County Assessor and the Treasurer-Tax Collector, together with other supporting documentation as may be required in order to place said special taxes on the secured property tax roll for the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 and to perform all other acts which are required by the Act, Ordinance or by-law in order to accomplish the purpose of this Resolution.

**Resolution No. 3****RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AUTHORIZING LEASE-LEASEBACK PROJECTS, SELECTION OF A CONTRACTOR, EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF SITE LEASES, FACILITIES LEASES AND CONSTRUCTION PROVISIONS, AND OTHER ACTS RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF FIELD UPGRADE IMPROVEMENTS AT EL DORADO HIGH SCHOOL AND ESPERANZA HIGH SCHOOL**

WHEREAS, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District ("District") desires to perform field upgrade improvements on a portion of the existing El Dorado High School campus located at 1651 Valencia Avenue and a portion of the existing Esperanza High School campus located at 1830 N. Kellogg Drive (the "Sites"), as lease-leaseback projects whereby the District will lease the Sites which the District owns to one or more builders ("Builder(s)") who will construct the respective Projects thereon and lease the respective Project and underlying Site back to the District;

WHEREAS, Education Code section 17406 authorizes the governing board of a school district, without advertising for bids, to let to any person, firm or corporation any real property belonging to the district if the instrument by which such property is let requires the lessee to construct on the demised premises, a building or buildings for use of the school district during the term thereof, and provides that title to the building shall vest in the school at the expiration of that term;

WHEREAS, the District has previously approved Preliminary Design Services Agreements for pre-construction services related to the proposed Projects;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the District to cause the construction of the Projects through lease and sublease of the Sites pursuant to Education Code section 17406;

WHEREAS, in order to complete the Projects, it is necessary that the District enter into a Site Lease for each Project, in which the each respective Site will be leased to a Builder, and a Facilities Lease which provides for the sublease of each respective Site and the lease of each respective Project by the Builder to the District, and that certain other action be taken and authorized;

WHEREAS, the Facilities Leases include construction provisions with which the Builder shall comply with respect to construction of the respective Project ("Construction Provisions");

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17402 of the Education Code, the plans and specifications for the Projects must be prepared and adopted prior to entering into respective Site Leases and the Facilities Leases for the Projects ("Plans and Specifications");

WHEREAS, the Plans and Specifications for each Project have been submitted to the Division of the State Architect ("DSA");

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17280 et seq., District shall obtain the DSA preliminary approval of the Plans and Specifications for the Projects subject to minor revisions, if any, prior to execution of the respective Site Leases or Facilities Leases, and prior to commencement of the Projects;

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with the Plans and Specifications for the Projects and has examined and approves of such documents, subject to minor revisions, if any, by DSA, and subject to the delegation of authority provided by the Board as set forth below;



WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with the draft form of each document referred to herein relating to the transaction contemplated hereby and the Board has examined and approves of each document and desires to authorize and direct the execution of such documents, once finalized, and the consummation of such transactions, subject to the delegation of authority provided by the Board as set forth below;

WHEREAS, in order to ensure that moneys sufficient to pay all costs will be available for the Projects, the District desires to appropriate funds for the Projects from its current fiscal year as provided by the Facilities Leases;

WHEREAS, all acts, conditions, and things required by the laws of the State of California to exist, to have happened and to have been performed precedent to and in connection with the consummation of the transaction authorized hereby, do exist, have happened and have been performed in regular and due time, form and manner as required by law, and the District is now duly authorized and empowered, pursuant to each and every requirement of law, to consummate such financing for the purpose, in the manner, and upon the terms herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.     Recitals. All of the recitals herein contained are true and correct.

Section 2.     Plans and Specifications. The Board hereby approves of the Plans and Specifications for the Projects, subject to minor revisions, if any, by DSA, and hereby provides a delegation of Board authority to the District's Superintendent ("Superintendent") who is authorized and directed, for and in the name and on behalf of the District, to approve of any such DSA approved Plans and Specifications, or revisions thereto.

Section 3.     Site Leases, Facilities Leases, and Builder(s). The form of agreements entitled "Site Lease" and the form of agreements entitled "Facilities Lease" (with Construction Provisions attached thereto as Exhibit "D"), each presented to this meeting and each to be entered into by and between the District and the Builder for each Project which together provide generally for (i) the lease by the District of each respective Site to a Builder, (ii) the sublease of each respective Site and the lease of the respective Project by the Builder to the District, and (iii) the payment of certain lease payments by the District under the each Facilities Lease in an amount equal to the aggregate construction costs for the respective Project as set forth in the Construction Provisions ("Lease Payments") are hereby approved subject to any revisions which are acceptable to the Superintendent and District's legal counsel. The Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed, for and in the name and on behalf of the District, to select a Builder for each respective Project, to negotiate and finalize the respective Site Lease and Facilities Lease documents with the selected Builder(s), including a guaranteed maximum sum amount including all construction costs ("Guaranteed Maximum Sum") for each respective Project, and to deliver to the selected Builder(s) such agreements, once finalized, pursuant to the delegation of authority provided for hereby.

Section 4.     Other Acts; Delegation. The District's Governing Board hereby approves a delegation of authority and appoints the Superintendent, or the designee of the Superintendent, who is/are hereby authorized and directed, to negotiate, execute and deliver the documents contemplated in Sections 2 and 3 above, and to do any and all things necessary, in consultation with the staff, that they may deem necessary or advisable in order to effectuate the purpose and intent of this Resolution, all subject to ratification of the Board of Education, if necessary. Said delegation shall be valid during the construction of the Projects, or until otherwise rescinded by the Board.

Section 5.     Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2****RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AUTHORIZING FILING AN APPLICATION FOR QUALIFIED SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION BOND ALLOCATION WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, AND APPROVING RELATED MATTERS AND OFFICIAL ACTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 added Section 54F to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, authorizing the issuance of qualified school construction bonds ("QSCBs"), in a principal amount of \$11 billion for calendar year 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the total allocation provided to the State of California for calendar year 2009 is \$773,525,000, excluding allocations which have been specifically provided to certain designated large local educational agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the statewide allocation of QSCBs for California is being administered by the California Department of Education (the "Department of Education"), and applications for such allocation have recently been made available for that purpose by the Department of Education; and

**WHEREAS**, Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (the "District") presently has authorized but unissued general obligation bonds authorized by an election on February 5, 2008 within the District in the original total amount of \$200,000,000; and

**WHEREAS**, such application for QSCBs will be received by the Department of Education starting July 15, 2009 with a \$25,000,000 cap per district; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of the District wishes to approve the filing of an application for QSCBs with the Department of Education and ensure that all of the certifications are made as required by such application;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Education of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District as follows:

**Section 1. Authorization to File QSCBs Application.** The Board of Education hereby authorizes the filing of an application with the Department of Education for allocation to issue QSCBs in calendar year 2009, in the principal amount of not to exceed \$25,000,000. The Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Qualified School Construction Bond 2009 Application in the form attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein (the "Application"), and all supporting documentation, to be completed and filed with the Department of Education not later than the deadline specified by the Department of Education for filing such application. The Board of Education hereby certifies that the District will comply with certifications 1 through 6 of the Application, as set forth more fully herein.

**Section 2. Issuance of QSCBs as General Obligation Bonds.** The Board of Education hereby declares its intention that the QSCBs shall be issued by the District as general obligation bonds which have previously been authorized for issuance by the voters of the District. The Board of Education has previously adopted a resolution authorizing the issuance of such general obligation bonds and approving proceedings for the sale thereof, in accordance with the ballot measure authorizing such general obligation bonds and in accordance with the applicable laws of the State of California.

**Section 3. Designation and Construction of Projects.** All of the proceeds received by the District from the issuance of QSCBs shall be applied for the purpose of financing (a) the construction, rehabilitation or repair of public school facilities, (b) the acquisition of land on which public school facilities will be constructed with the proceeds of the QSCBs, or (c) equipment related to the project(s)

to be constructed or rehabilitated with the proceeds of the QSCBs. As required by applicable law, all laborers and mechanics employed by contractors or subcontractors on projects funded by the QSCBs shall be paid wages and fringe benefits at rates not less than those prevailing on similar projects in the locality. Within six months of the issuance of the QSCBs, the District must have entered into contract(s) for the use of proceeds at least equal to 10% of issuance. Additionally, 100% of the proceeds of the proceeds of the QSCBs are to be used for a qualified purpose and must be spent within three years of the date of issuance of the QSCBs.

**Section 4. Prohibition on Financial Conflicts of Interest.** The District shall assure that all applicable State of California and local law requirements governing conflicts of interest are satisfied with respect to the issuance of the QSCBs, and if additional conflict of interest rules are imposed by Internal Revenue Service regulation, such additional rules will be satisfied with respect to the issuance of the QSCBs.

**Section 5. Filings with Department of Education.** Within 15 days of issuing the QSCBs, the District will submit a copy of IRS Form 8038 to the Department of Education. In addition, at the conclusion of the project(s), the District shall submit a completion report to the Department of Education.

**Section 6. Unused Allocation.** In the event that the District does not issue the QSCBs in the full amount of the authorization by December 31, 2009, the District hereby declares that any and all unused portion of the authorization, without further action by the Board of Education, shall revert to the State of California (CDE), to be allocated or reallocated as determined by the Department of Education in its sole discretion.

**Section 7. Engagement of Professional Services.** The Board of Education hereby approves the engagement of the firm of George K. Baum & Company to act as underwriter to the District and the firm of Jones Hall, A Professional Law Corporation, to serve as bond counsel to the District, in connection with the issuance of the QSCBs. All fees and expenses payable to such firms shall be contingent upon the approval to issue the QSCBs by the Department of Education and the issuance and sale of the QSCBs. The Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement between each of said firms and the District, in the form on file with the Superintendent or to amend any prior agreements with said firms.

**Section 8. Official Actions.** The Superintendent, the Assistant Superintendent of Administrative Services, and all other officers of the District, are hereby authorized and directed for and in the name and on behalf of the District to do any and all things and take any and all actions relating to the execution and delivery of any and all certificates, requisitions, agreements and other documents, which they, or any of them, may deem necessary or advisable in order to consummate any of the matters approved by this Resolution.

**Section 9. Effective Date of Resolution.** This Resolution will take effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption.
