**RESOLUTION NO. 39  
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE  
PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**

On motion of Member Eric Padget, duly seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted.

**WHEREAS**, the District no longer has the financial ability or resources to provide all services which it is currently providing given the current recession faced by the State of California and by school districts throughout the State;

**WHEREAS**, in order to maintain a balanced budget and provide for essential services, the District must eliminate programs and services in the 2010-2011 fiscal year;

**WHEREAS**, it will be necessary to reduce or discontinue the particular kinds of services now being rendered by certificated personnel for the 2010-2011 fiscal year as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference;

**WHEREAS**, the reduction or elimination of said services may result in the reassignment and/or lay off of certificated employees.

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the Superintendent to give notice to employees who may be laid off as a result of reduction in services prior to March 15, 2010.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Superintendent or his designee hereby directed to give written notice prior to March 15, 2010 to certificated employees pursuant to EC 44949 and 44955 in order to reduce the number of certificated positions as outlined in Exhibit A.

**WHEREAS** that employees who first rendered paid service to the District on the same date, be laid off solely on the basis of the needs of the District, as determined by the following tie breaker criteria:

1. One point for CLAD or English Language (EL) authorization.
2. One point for each additional credential authorizing services in a subject area currently not being rendered.
3. One point for a clear (versus preliminary) teaching credential.
4. One point for each advanced degree (Masters, Doctorate).

If the criteria listed above do not break a tie, the District shall hold a lottery at least five working days prior to the layoff hearing. Each group of tied employees shall have the right to attend the lottery and pick a lottery number. In the absence of the employee, the Assistant Superintendent of Personnel Services will select a lottery number on behalf of the employee.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Superintendent or his designee is authorized and directed to give notices to certificated employees as is necessary to implement this resolution and as required by District Rules and Regulations and applicable provisions of the Education Code of the State of California.
