RESOLUTION NO. 1

RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ACTING AS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1 AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF SPECIAL TAXES FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (the "Board") has heretofore taken proceedings pursuant to the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982, as amended, (the "Act") for the establishment of Community Facilities District No. 1 (the "District") for the purpose of providing educational facilities for the use of residents of the District; and

WHEREAS, following a special election of the qualified electors of the District, this Board on November 12, 2002 acting as the governing body of the District, adopted Ordinance No. 1 ("Ordinance") which provided for the levying and collection of Special Taxes within the District, "as provided in the Act and Ordinance and as approved by the qualified electors"; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary and appropriate that this Board levy and collect the Special Taxes for Fiscal Year 2014-2015, by the adoption of a resolution as specified by the Act and Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In accordance with the Act and Ordinance, there is hereby levied upon all properties within the District which are not otherwise exempt from taxation under the Act or Ordinance the special taxes for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 set forth in the Ordinance at the tax rates as set forth therein and in Exhibit "A" hereto, as may be amended without further action of the Board to reflect updated information on assessor's parcel numbers from the County of Orange. The Assistant Superintendent, Fiscal Services, is hereby authorized and directed to establish the final rates to be levied, which final rates shall not exceed the maximum rates.

Section 2. The above-authorized special taxes shall be collected in the same manner as ad valorem property taxes on the secured roll by the Treasurer-Tax Collector of the County of Orange and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedure and sale in cases of delinquency as provided for such ad valorem taxes.

Section 3. The Clerk and Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, are hereby authorized to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Orange County Assessor and the Treasurer-Tax Collector, together with other supporting documentation as may be required in order to place said special taxes on the secured property tax roll for the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 and to perform all other acts which are required by the Act, Ordinance or by-law in order to accomplish the purpose of this Resolution.
