1. Mrs. Carrie Buck reported that she attended the Orange County School Board Association Dinner and heard Kevin Gordon speak. She felt Mr. Gordon was well informed and provided good information. **RESOLUTION NO. 16  
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT  
GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT AN EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) TO YORBA LINDA  
WATER DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the Yorba Linda Water District (“Water District”) has requested that the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (“School District”) dedicate an easement to Yorba Linda Water District upon a portion of the School District’s Yorba Linda High School site (“Easement”). A legal description and map depicting the location of the Easement is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17556, the governing board of a school district may convey to any public corporation, or private corporation engaged in the public utility business, any real property belonging to such school district upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree;

**WHEREAS**, the School District desires to provide an Easement to Yorba Linda Water District for the purposes of construction, installation and maintenance of a water pipeline and related appurtenances, as well as ingress and egress of equipment and persons employed by or on behalf of YLWD in connection with the construction, installation and maintenance of the pipeline and related appurtenances;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must, prior to dedicating an Easement, adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate such Easement in a regular open meeting by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all of its members;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must fix a time at its regular place of meeting for a public hearing upon the question of making the dedication of the Easement; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17558, the School District is required to post copies of this Resolution, signed by the board, in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries not less than ten (10) days before the public hearing, and publish notice once, not less than five (5) days before the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the School District, if there is one, or, if there is no such newspaper published in the School District, then in a newspaper published in the county which has a general circulation in the School District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the above recitals are all true and correct.

**Section 2.** That the School District’s governing board (“Board”) declares its intent to dedicate the Easement to Yorba Linda Water District upon the terms and conditions set forth in the recitals.

**Section 3.** That the Board establishes November 17, 2015 for a public hearing on the question of the School District’s intent to dedicate the Easement to Yorba Linda Water District.

**Section 4.** The School District staff shall post this resolution in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries and publish notice of the adoption of this Resolution in compliance with Education Code section 17558.






**VICINITY MAP**







STANDARDIZED TESTING AND REPORTING  
CALIFORNIA ASSESSMENT OF STUDENT PERFORMANCE AND PROGRESS  
AND ACCOMMODATIONS FOR STUDENTS

*The State of California has developed a comprehensive accountability system entitled Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP). This system requires participation of all students in the state in grades 2 3 through 8 and 11. The results of the assessment program are used to describe what students know and can do in relation to state content standards and to evaluate how schools and programs are progressing in providing students with the desired knowledge and skills.*

*The tests included in the STAR CAASPP program have been “standardized.” Specific directions, time allotments, and sample test items, and supplementary testing materials such as rulers for measuring have been included in the testing materials are available so that students throughout the state take the tests under the same conditions. The exams are adaptive and adjust based on student response. However, the State of California recognizes that some students need accommodations or modifications to these standardized procedures in order to demonstrate their learning. The State has developed appropriate accommodations and modifications and requires districts to establish guidelines describing the conditions under which a student shall have access to a standard or nonstandard accommodation. The state has developed a set of universal tools, designated supports and accommodations to provide greater access to the test questions for all students, including those students with disabilities served under an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or a 504 accommodation plan. These include, for example, language glossaries, additional breaks, marking for review, text-to-speech, and American Sign Language.*

- ~~1. Standard accommodations are available to any student and do not alter the procedures or materials used during the testing situation.~~
- ~~2. Nonstandard accommodations are those in which materials and procedures vary from those used during standardization and may affect the validity of the test scores.~~
  - ~~a. Nonstandard accommodations for a student with an Individual Educational Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan may only be used if they are specified in the student’s IEP or 504 Plan and must match accommodations regularly used during classroom instruction.~~
  - ~~b. Nonstandard accommodations for English learners relate to their access to the English language.~~

Furthermore, a student may be exempt from all or part of the test(s) if:

1. The student has an IEP that exempts him/her from the Standardized Testing and Reporting program CAASPP and an the California Alternate Assessment is given.
2. The student’s parent/guardian has submitted a written form or note opting him or her out of one or all of the tests in the STAR CAASPP program.

**Age of Admission to Kindergarten**

Initial admission to kindergarten shall be accomplished solely on the basis of chronological age as outlined in the Education Code. As amended by the Kindergarten Readiness Act of 2010, ~~the age for admission into kindergarten gradually rises over a four-year period.~~ children are eligible for kindergarten enrollment if they have their fifth birthday ~~on or before December 2 in 2011-12, November 1 in 2012-13, October 1 in 2013-14, and on or before September 1. in 2014-15 and beyond.~~

**Age of Admission to Transitional Kindergarten (Preppy K)**

The district's transitional kindergarten (Preppy K) program shall admit children whose fifth birthday lies ~~between November 2 and December 2 in the 2012-13 school year, October 2 and December 2 in the 2013-14 school year, and is from September 2 and through December 2 in the 2014-15 school year and each school year thereafter.~~ Any child who will have his/her fifth birthday ~~between September 2 and December 2 may enroll in transitional kindergarten (Preppy K) prior to 2014-15 upon parent request.~~

**Age of Admission to Expanded Transitional Kindergarten (Preppy K)**

As amended by AB 104, children are eligible to enroll in Expanded Transitional Kindergarten classes on a space available basis. The amendment allows for the admittance of any child who will have his/her birthday after December 2<sup>nd</sup> but during that same school year. Pupils who enter as Expanded Transitional Kindergartners may attend from the beginning of the school year and will generate ADA when they attain the age of five.

**Other Admissions**

Admission of children to other grades shall involve a consideration of both chronological age and the readiness of the children to do the work of each grade level.


