INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE STUDENTS

The Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District recognizes that interaction between students of different countries and cultures promotes global awareness and international understanding. To that end, the district welcomes the enrollment of international students.

To enroll in a district school, an international exchange student must be participating in a program registered with the California Attorney General’s Office, designated by the U.S. Department of State and accepted for listing on the Council for Standards for International Educational Travel’s Advisory List.

When necessary because of overcrowding within the district’s schools or limited district resources, the Superintendent or designee may limit the number of international students to be accepted at any district high school during any school year.

The district shall not incur any financial obligations when receiving international students. Program sponsors or guardians shall provide assurance of their responsibility for health/ accident/liability insurance, and the student’s home placement.

District staff shall provide relevant counseling to district students who wish to study in a foreign country. District credit for courses successfully completed in the foreign country shall be granted in accordance with board policy and administrative regulation.

NUMBER OF BOARD MEMBERS AND TERM OF OFFICE

Number

The Board of Education of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District is composed of five members who are elected at large by the electors of the district as their non-partisan representatives on school matters.

In addition, one student shall be appointed to the Board as a non-voting member. The student selected to serve shall be enrolled in a district high school and shall be an elected or appointed Associated Student Body officer/member or a member of the school's student leadership team. The student member shall have the right and responsibility to attend all meetings of the Board of Education except closed sessions. Rotation among the district's high schools shall be as follows: El Camino Real, Parkview/La Entrada, Esperanza, El Dorado, Valencia, and Yorba Linda High Schools.

Term of Office

Each person elected to the Board of Education at the regular biennial election shall hold office for a term of four years, commencing on the first Friday in December next succeeding their election. The four-year term expires on the first Friday in December following the election of new members.

The terms of Board members shall be staggered so that approximately half of the Board, i.e., either two or three members, shall be elected in each even-numbered year.

A member whose term has expired shall continue to discharge the duties of the office until his/her successor has qualified by taking the oath of office.

The student board member shall serve a one semester term commencing on the first Board meeting in September for the first semester term and on the first Board meeting in February for the second semester term.

The Secretary to the Board shall maintain a properly authenticated official copy of the board-approved minutes in accordance with law.

The Secretary to the Board shall maintain a record of policies and bylaws adopted by the Board and of administrative regulations in accordance with Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District Board Bylaw 9310, *Board Policies, Regulations and Bylaws*.


