**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

- Superintendent Greg Plutko reported that the Assistant Superintendent of Business, Mr. David Giordano, would be presenting later in the agenda on the First Interim Report. Dr. Plutko thanked Mr. Giordano and his team for their work in preparing an outstanding budget.
- Superintendent Plutko presented Director of Technology Jeremy Powell and his team with a certificate from FCMAT/CSIS for data management recognition to acknowledge the efforts of PYLUSD to meet the CALPADS submission certification deadlines and maintain quality data.
- Deputy Superintendent Candy Plahy gave a brief presentation on the plans to move forward with the Local Control Accountability Program (LCAP).

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT (Continued)**

- The Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District met the criteria for the AP District Honor Roll and has been recognized for this honor in 2017. This is a special distinction and PYLUSD was only one of four districts in Orange County who were recognized this year. We will have a follow-up presentation at an upcoming Board Meeting as this is a great source of pride for our district.
- In Cabinet meeting we have been discussing being a future ready district and had several examples of this. Dr. Andrea Norman gave one example as she spoke about a flipped classroom environment and what that meant. We have found ways across the district to challenge our students using technology and allowing our students to grow. At an upcoming meeting, we will have a report that talks about examples of our future ready in action in our district.
- The Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District was named as a Top Work Place 2017 in all of Orange County. This is a tremendous achievement for us. The Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) created a promotional video on our district and Dr. Plutko thanked them for publicizing the video.

**DISTRICT AND SCHOOL WEBSITES**

To enhance communication with students, parents/guardians, staff, and community members, the Governing Board encourages the Superintendent or designee to develop and maintain district and school websites. The use of district and school websites shall support the district's vision and goals and shall be coordinated with other district communications strategies.

**Design Standards**

The Superintendent or designee shall establish design standards for district and school websites in order to maintain a consistent identity, professional appearance, and ease of use.

The district's design standards shall address the accessibility of district-sponsored and school-sponsored websites to individuals with disabilities, including compatibility with commonly used assistive technologies.

**Guidelines for Content**

The Superintendent or designee shall develop content guidelines for district and school websites and shall assign staff to review and approve content prior to posting.

Board policy pertaining to advertising in district and school publications, as specified in BP 1325 - Advertising and Promotion, shall also apply to advertising on district and school websites.

**Privacy Rights**

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that the privacy rights of students, parents/guardians, staff, Board members, and other individuals are protected on district and school websites.

Telephone numbers and home and email addresses of students and/or their parents/guardians shall not be published on district or school websites.

Photographs of students, such as at a school event, may be published, together with their names, with prior written consent of the parent/legal guardian of the student.

Staff members' home addresses or telephone numbers shall not be posted on district or school websites.

The home address or telephone number of any elected or appointed official including, but not limited to, a Board member or public safety official, shall not be posted on district or school websites without the prior written permission of that individual.

No public safety official shall be required to consent to the posting on the Internet of his/her photograph or identity as a public safety officer for any purpose if that officer reasonably believes that the disclosure may result in a threat, harassment, intimidation, or harm to the officer or his/her family.

**DISTRICT-SPONSORED SOCIAL MEDIA**

The Governing Board recognizes the value of technology such as social media platforms in promoting community involvement and collaboration. The purpose of any official district social media platform shall be to further the district's vision and mission, support student learning and staff professional development, and enhance communication with students, parents/guardians, staff, and community members.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop content guidelines and protocols for official district social media platforms to ensure the appropriate and responsible use of these resources and compliance with applicable laws, regulations, Board policy, and administrative regulations.

**Guidelines for Content**

Official district social media platforms shall be used only for their stated purposes and in a manner consistent with this policy and administrative regulation. By creating these official sites and allowing for public comment, the Board does not intend to create a limited public forum or otherwise guarantee an individual's right to free speech.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that the limited purpose of the official district social media platforms is clearly communicated to users. Each site shall contain a statement that specifies the site's purposes along with a statement that users are expected to use the site only for those purposes. Each site shall also contain a statement that users are personally responsible for the content of their posts.

Official district social media platforms may not contain content that is obscene, libelous, or so incites students as to create a clear and present danger of the commission of unlawful acts on school premises, violation of school rules, or substantial disruption of the school's orderly operation.

Staff or students who post prohibited content shall be subject to discipline in accordance with district policies and administrative regulations.

Users of official district social media platforms should be aware of the public nature and accessibility of social media and that information posted may be considered a public record subject to disclosure under the Public Records Act. The Board expects users to conduct themselves in a respectful, courteous, and professional manner.

Social media posts and comments by third parties on District social media accounts are not retained by the District and are subject to the retention policies or procedures of the social media platform.

**Privacy**

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that the privacy rights of students, parents/guardians, staff, Board members, and other individuals are protected on official district social media platforms.

Board policy pertaining to the posting of student photographs and the privacy of telephone numbers,

home addresses, and email addresses, as specified in BP 1113 - District and School Web Sites, shall also apply to official district social media platforms.

Social media and networking sites and other online platforms shall not be used by district employees to transmit confidential information about students, employees, or district operations.
