STUDENT BOARD REPORT

Student Board Representative Kiara Espericueta provided a brief report of the activities and events occurring at the district's high schools.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Dr. Plutko commented on the special evening of recognitions and how encouraging it is to feel immediately injected with the energy from the audience, especially those high school students who chose to honor their teachers and activities directors by their presence tonight. Listening to Kiara Espericueta give her student board report of what is going on in her world reminds us of the grace and altruism of our young people. It is a great source of pride to hear the report of our students' work to help others who might be less fortunate.
- Superintendent Plutko and Deputy Superintendent Candy Plahy have visited a number of our schools over the past month. Dr. Plutko took a moment to commend and thank all of our language arts teachers and our ELD instructors. A new adoption is a huge change, and it is impressive to visit the classrooms and see the progress they have made since the beginning of the year. It takes a tremendous amount of effort, and we have strong instructional leaders who are doing a great job in our district.
- Dr. Plutko reflected on an article he read about the importance of communication in large organizations. He recognized that the systems we have in place are committees like Superintendent's Community Advisory Committee, Teacher Advisory Committee, High School Advisory Committee, PTAs, DELAC, and CAC meetings. All of these represent the level of communication and our willingness to know what is going on in our district. It is a nice compliment to our district and everyone involved.
- The District Band Pageant sold out! It was an impressive night and an example of great health in our district.
- This evening we have a student data presentation. Dr. Plutko thanked Mrs. Plahy for her leadership in everything we do instructionally in this district and for the work that has gone into this presentation. Lastly, we will get to see a video on our Dual Language Academy.

In addition, she attended the ABC Teacher Pathway Open House and will be visiting Glenview to see the Dual Immersion Program. She participated in the District Band Pageant as well as the “Sinfonia” Orchestra Concert. RESOLUTION NO. 15

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MAP OF PROPOSED TRUSTEE AREAS AND PROPOSED SEQUENCE OF ELECTIONS AND RECOMMENDING THAT THE COUNTY COMMITTEE APPROVE AND ESTABLISH TRUSTEE AREAS

WHEREAS, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (“District”) does not have trustee areas for the members of its Board of Education (“Board”), and the District currently utilizes an “at-large” method of election to select Board members; and

WHEREAS, the Board is aware that under state law an at-large method of election may be subject to challenge under the California Voting Rights Act of 2001 (“CVRA”), California Elections Code §§ 14025, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, “by-trustee area” electoral systems are not vulnerable to challenge under the CVRA; and

WHEREAS, in a by-trustee area system of election, candidates for the Board must reside within a specific geographic subarea of the District called a “trustee area” and candidates are elected only by the voters of that trustee area; and

WHEREAS, it is the Board’s intent and desire to change its election methodology from an at-large system to a by-trustee area method of election as described in Education Code section 5030(b); and

WHEREAS, one method of transitioning from an at-large electoral system to a by-trustee area electoral system is for the school district governing board to petition the local county committee on school district organization by resolution to initiate the transition under California Education Code Section 5019(c)(1); and

WHEREAS, this Resolution shall serve as the District’s proposal to the County Committee pursuant to Education Code Section 5019(c)(1); and

WHEREAS, to avoid the cost, expense, and uncertainty associated with allegations of violations of the CVRA, the District has proceeded expeditiously to change its current at-large election system; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2017, the Board adopted Resolution No. 4, directing the Superintendent or his designee, among other things, to immediately initiate the process of changing the method of electing members of the Board, from the current at-large system whereby each member of the Board is elected by the registered voters of the entire District (Education Code Section 5030(a)), to a method which provides that Board members residing in each trustee area will be elected by the registered voters of that particular trustee area (Education Code Section 5030(b)), in sufficient time for the new method of electing members of the Board to be in place for the November 2018 election; and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2017, the Board conducted the first public hearing regarding the composition of trustee areas, as required by Elections Code Section 10010; and

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2017, the Board conducted the second public hearing regarding the composition of trustees areas, as required by Elections Code Section 10010; and

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2017, the Board adopted Resolution No. 9, establishing criteria for the demographer to consider in preparation of the draft map scenarios and directed the demographer to present such maps at a future Board meeting; and

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2017, three draft trustee area maps and proposed sequencing of elections were made available to the public;

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2017, the Board conducted the first public hearing on draft trustee area maps Green, Orange, and Purple, as required by Elections Code Section 10010. Further, Board input was received during the public hearing. There was one public comment. The Board provided direction to retain all three draft trustee area maps for further consideration at the second public hearing on November 7, 2017; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2017, the Board held the second public hearing regarding the content of proposed maps and the proposed sequence of elections, as required by Elections Code Section 10010. Further community and Board input was solicited during the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2017, the Board held a public hearing regarding the transition from an at-large to a by-trustee area method of election to select Board members; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered all such public input and comment on the draft trustee area maps and proposed sequence of elections; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to adopt Map Green and hereby recommends Map Green to the County Committee for its consideration based upon the findings and analysis contained in the documents attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "1"; and

WHEREAS, in order to complete the transition to by-trustee area elections in a timely and cost-effective manner, and to guarantee that the new by-trustee area process will be in place in time to elect new governing board members at the Board's next regularly-scheduled election, the District must obtain a waiver of the election process as set forth in Education Code Sections 5019, 5020, 5021 and 5030 from the State Board of Education.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District as follows:

1. That the above recitals are true and correct.
2. That the Board hereby adopts Map Green and recommends Map Green to the County Committee for consideration and adoption.
3. That at the District's next election in 2018, seats in trustee areas 4 and 5 will be up for election, and in November 2020, seats in trustee areas 1, 2, and 3 will be up for election.
4. That the Superintendent or designee may take all actions necessary to notify the County Committee of the Board's determination herein and provide whatever assistance may be required by the Committee to complete the process, including the holding of at least one Committee meeting in the District.
5. That the Superintendent or his designee shall be authorized to take any additional acts needed to effectuate the purpose and intent of this resolution.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REQUEST FOR WAIVER
OF THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF TRUSTEE AREAS
AND ADOPTION OF A “BY-TRUSTEE AREA” ELECTION PROCESS
BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORS AS SET FORTH IN EDUCATION CODE
SECTIONS 5019, 5020, 5021 AND 5030**

WHEREAS, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (“District”) does not have trustee areas for the members of its Board of Education (“Board”), and the District currently utilizes an “at-large” method of election to select Board members; and

WHEREAS, the Board is aware that under state law an at-large method of election may be subject to challenge under the California Voting Rights Act of 2001 (“CVRA”), California Elections Code §§ 14025, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, “by-trustee area” electoral systems are not vulnerable to challenge under the CVRA; and

WHEREAS, in a by-trustee area system of election, candidates for the Board must reside within a specific geographic subarea of the District called a “trustee area” and candidates are elected only by the voters of that trustee area; and

WHEREAS, one method of transitioning from an at-large electoral system to a by-trustee area electoral system is for the school district board of trustees to petition the local county committee on school district organization by resolution to initiate the transition under California Education Code Section 5019(c)(1); and

WHEREAS, the District intends to petition to the Orange County Committee on School District Organization (“Committee”) to initiate this process on behalf of the District; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Education Code Section 5020 and related sections, the establishment of trustee areas and adoption of a by-trustee area election process must be put to a vote by the electors of the District; and

WHEREAS, several school districts in California have been sued or threatened with a lawsuit for alleged violations of the CVRA by a group that has filed several such lawsuits over the past few years as a result of such school districts’ at-large election systems; and

WHEREAS, to avoid the cost, expense, and uncertainty inherent in such litigation, the District proceeded expeditiously to change its current at-large election system; and

WHEREAS, in order to complete the transition in a timely manner and to guarantee that the new by-trustee area process will be in place in time to elect new governing board members at the Board’s next regularly-scheduled election in November 2018, the District must obtain a waiver of the election process of Education Code Sections 5019, 5020, 5021 and 5030 from the State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 33050 et seq. allows the governing board of a school district to request the State Board of Education to waive all or part of any section of the Education Code or any regulation adopted by the State Board of Education that implements a provision of the Education Code, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 5020 and related sections are not listed as exceptions in Education Code Section 33050 et seq. and can thus be waived; and

WHEREAS, to obtain a waiver, the District must comply with Education Code and California Department of Education and State Board of Education regulations; and

WHEREAS, the District must consult with all collective bargaining units; and

WHEREAS, the District must consult with any advisory and other committees or councils with an interest in the waiver; and

WHEREAS, the District must conduct a properly noticed public hearing, at which time the public may testify on the merits of obtaining a waiver from the State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, the District must submit a complete General Waiver Request form to the California Department of Education.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District as follows:

1. That the above recitals are true and correct.
2. That the Board hereby declares the Board's intention to seek a waiver of Education Code Section 5020 and portions of related sections pertaining to the requirement that the establishment of trustee areas and adoption of a by-trustee area election process must be put to a vote by the electors of the District.
3. That the District has consulted, and will continue to consult, with all collective bargaining units, made every effort to include them as a participant in the waiver process, and shall note the collective bargaining units' position regarding the waiver in the District's General Waiver Request.
4. That the District has consulted, and will continue to consult, with all committees and councils with an interest in the waiver, and, where required, shall note the position of such groups regarding the waiver in the District's General Waiver Request.
5. That the District distributed a notice specifically inviting public testimony regarding the waiver, and said notice was printed in a newspaper of general circulation and included the date, time, location, and subject of the hearing.
6. That on November 7, 2017, the District conducted a properly noticed public hearing held during a board meeting at which time the public was able to testify on the waiver proposal.

7. That the District's Superintendent and/or his designee, is authorized and directed to submit a General Waiver Request to the California Department of Education, seeking a waiver of the requirement that the establishment of trustee areas and adoption of a by-trustee area election process must be put to a vote by the electors of the District under Education Code Section 5020 and related sections in order to ensure the timely adoption of the District's trustee areas and the District's transition from its current at-large electoral process to a by-trustee area electoral process.

8. That the Superintendent or his designee shall be authorized to take any additional acts needed to effectuate the purpose and intent of this resolution.

E. Article 11: Class Size

F. Article 13: Evaluation

The District has an interest in reviewing the contract language associated with evaluation procedures and forms.

G. Article XIV: Wages and Benefits

The District has an interest in reviewing the contract language associated with wages and benefits. The District also has an interest in updating Peer Assistance and Review terminology and language.

H. Article XVI: Professional Day


The District has an interest in updating the number of service days a unit member will work.
