Mrs. Judi Carmona mentioned she will go to Topaz tomorrow for the Second Harvest Food Bank and will help hand out gently-used clothing and books for the families to use in their homes.

Mr. Eric Padget wanted to point out that District executive staff made phone calls on the first day to reach out to new teachers to see how they were doing and lend support. He received amazing feedback from teachers that felt supported from the top on down. He thanked classified staff and contractors for their hard work to get schools in the best shape, and they look good. He will be attending Esperanza High School’s back-to-school night tomorrow and has others on his calendar as well. Mr. Padget brought up a point that there is no straight ADA access from the parking lot to the turf field at Esperanza High School and wanted to let the community know that we are working on it.

Mrs. Carol Downey thanked staff and everyone for a smooth school opening. She knows how hard they work to get everything up and running and looking good. Mrs. Downey mentioned an editorial in the *LA Times* that reported a study showed it is an advantage for our schools to start at a later time. Senate Bill 328, which would require that the school day for middle and high schools begin no earlier than 8:30, passed in the Senate and is headed to the Assembly. Scientific studies show that later start times are linked to reduction in tardiness, absences, improvement in graduation rates, and overall teen wellness. She is for evidence-based changes if it shows something is better.

Mrs. Karin Freeman agreed that the start of school was very good. In particular, she gave credit to the hard work that Jeremy Powell and Kevin Quinn did on the transition from posting teacher lists to online notification that affected elementary levels. She also thanked the Print Shop for their support of the Esperanza High School campus. Mrs. Freeman represents this district on the NOCROP Board and they met for two days of strategic planning. She will share the end product when it is completed. The Orange County Committee on School District Organization met and voted on transfer of territory which was approved by 9 members of committee. In support of our scholars, the Education Committee of Yorba Linda will have *Bingo Night and Bites* at Yorba Linda Community Center to raise money for high school scholarships on Monday, October 16. Mrs. Freeman encouraged everyone to attend the Susanna Bixby Bryant Ranch Open House Saturday, September 30, from 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.

WHEREAS, the procedures require that school districts take appropriate action to ensure the availability of textbooks and instructional materials on a yearly basis, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Sections 60119 and 60422(b), the Board is required to hold a public hearing to encourage participation by parents, teachers, members of the community interested in the affairs of the school district, and bargaining unit leaders, and;

WHEREAS, the Board is required to provide ten days' notice of the public hearing or hearings, and;

WHEREAS, the notice shall contain the time, place, and purpose of the hearing and be posted in three public places within the school district, and;

WHEREAS, the hearing shall be held at a time that will encourage the attendance of teachers and parents and guardians of pupils who attend the schools in the district and shall not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

WHEREAS, the governing Board of a school district, as part of the required hearing, shall also make a written determination as to whether each pupil enrolled in a foreign language, or health course has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board for those subjects, and;

WHEREAS, the governing Board shall also determine the availability of laboratory science equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in Grades 9 – 12, inclusive, and;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on September 12, 2017, and;

WHEREAS, the Board is required to make a determination as to whether each pupil in each school in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board:



- (i) Mathematics
- (ii) Science
- (iii) History-social science
- (iv) English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program
- (v) Visual and performing arts

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing Board makes the determination that each pupil of the district, has available sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board and adopted by this Board in accordance with the procedures as established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2017 – 2018 school year, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District will provide each pupil with sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board for those subjects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2017 – 2018 school year, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District will provide sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board, to each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course and that sufficient laboratory science equipment applicable to science laboratory courses offered in Grades 9 – 12, inclusive, is available to pupils.

**SUICIDE PREVENTION**

The Governing Board recognizes that suicide is a leading cause of death among youth and that school personnel who regularly interact with students are often in a position to recognize the warning signs of suicide and to offer appropriate referral and/or assistance. In an effort to reduce suicidal behavior and its impact on students and families, the Superintendent or designee shall develop measures and strategies for suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention for students in middle and high school.

In developing measures and strategies for use by the district, the Superintendent or designee may consult with school health professionals, school counselors, school psychologists, school social workers, administrators, other staff, parents/guardians, students, local health agencies, mental health professionals, and community stakeholders.

Such measures and strategies shall include, but are not limited to:

1. Staff development on suicide awareness and prevention for teachers, school counselors, and school psychologists, who interact with students in the secondary grades on an annual/routine basis
  - a. Materials approved for training of teachers shall include risk factors and warning signs of suicide prevention, intervention strategies, and referral procedures.
  - b. Materials approved for training of school counselors and school psychologists shall include how to identify appropriate mental health services, both at the school site and within the larger community, and when and how to refer youth and their families to those services.
  - c. Materials approved for training may also include programs that can be completed through self-review of suitable suicide prevention materials.
  - d. District employees must act only within the authorization and scope of the employee's credential and/or license. Nothing in this policy shall be construed as authorizing or encouraging a school employee to diagnose or treat mental illness unless the employee is specifically credentialed or licensed and employed to do so.
2. Methods for promoting a positive school climate (i.e. ASB, PBIS, after-school programs) that enhance students' feelings of connectedness with the school and that is characterized by caring staff and harmonious interrelationships among students
3. The provision of information to parents/guardians regarding risk factors and warning signs of suicide, the severity of the youth suicide problem, basic steps for helping suicidal youth, and/or school and community resources that can help youth in crisis

- 4. Encouragement for students to notify appropriate school personnel or other adults when they are experiencing thoughts of suicide or when they suspect or have knowledge of another student's suicidal intentions
- 5. Crisis intervention procedures for addressing suicide threats or attempts
- 6. Counseling and other postvention strategies for helping students, staff, and others cope in the aftermath of a student's suicide

As appropriate, these measures and strategies shall specifically address the needs of students who are at high risk of suicide, including, but not limited to, students who are bereaved by suicide; students with disabilities, mental illness, or substance use disorders; students who are experiencing homelessness or who are in out-of-home settings such as foster care; and students who are lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or questioning youth.

The district has an interest in reviewing the contract language associated with leaves with regard to changes in applicable law.

**E. Article XVIII: Wages**

The district has an interest in reviewing the contract language associated with wages.

**F. Article XX: Health and Welfare**

The district has an interest in reviewing contract language associated with health and welfare benefits.

**RESOLUTION NO. 9**

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CRITERIA FOR DEVELOPING TRUSTEE AREA BOUNDARIES**

WHEREAS, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (“District”) does not have trustee areas for the members of its Board of Education (“Board”), and the District currently utilizes an “at-large” method of election to select Board members; and

WHEREAS, the Board is aware that under state law an at-large method of election may be subject to challenge under the California Voting Rights Act of 2001 (“CVRA”), California Elections Code §§ 14025, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 4, the Board has expressed its intent to change to the “by-trustee area” election methodology, pursuant to which each trustee must reside within a designated trustee area and is elected only by the voters in that trustee area in time for the Board’s November 2018 election; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965 § 2; 52 U.S.C. § 10301 (formerly 42 U.S.C. section 1973) prohibits the use of any voting qualification, or prerequisite to voting, or standard, practice, or procedure, in a manner which results in a denial or abridgement of the right of any citizen of the United States to vote on account of race or color; and

WHEREAS, federal law and the Equal Protection Clause require that each trustee area be equal in population to ensure compliance with the “one person, one vote” rule; however, deviations (less ten percent [10%] population deviation between the largest and smallest districts) are presumptively constitutional under the Equal Protection Clause; and

WHEREAS, the Board has retained an experienced demographic consulting firm, National Demographics Corporation (“NDC”) and experienced legal counsel to advise it on the process of preparing a trustee area plan for submission to the County Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Board now wishes to adopt criteria to guide the establishment of trustee areas consistent with legal requirements, including reasonably equal population and Section 2 of the Federal Voting Rights Act, and which address other concerns and considerations important to the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby finds the foregoing recitals to be true and correct; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby adopts the following criteria to guide the establishment of trustee areas for the elections of members of Board:

1. Each trustee area shall contain a nearly equal number of inhabitants;
2. Trustee area borders shall be drawn in a manner that complies with the Federal Voting Rights Act;
3. Trustee areas shall consist of contiguous territory in as compact a form as possible given the other criteria set forth herein;

4. Trustee area borders shall respect communities of interest as much as possible;
5. The boundaries of the trustee areas shall observe topography and geography, such as man-made geographical features including freeways, highways and major streets, etc. as natural divisions between trustee areas, insofar as practicable;
6. Trustee area borders shall consider school attendance zone boundaries, with emphasis on having multiple trustees representing each District high school attendance area to the extent possible;
7. Trustee area borders shall consider historic, pre-unification school district boundaries in the geographic area of the District, with emphasis on having multiple trustees representing each of those former boundaries, to respect unification, to the extent possible;
8. Trustee area borders shall consider jurisdictional boundaries as much as possible;
9. Trustee area borders shall attempt to avoid head-to-head contests between incumbent members of the Board insofar as this does not conflict with federal or state law; and
10. Trustee areas known to be areas of higher-than-average population growth in the seven years preceding the establishment of trustee areas and/or two to three years following the establishment of trustee areas may be underpopulated within the population deviation amounts allowed by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to instruct the professional demographer to formulate two or more trustee area plan scenarios based upon the criteria specified above for review by the public at public hearings and for consideration by the Board at future meetings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to publish the potential sequence of elections for review by the public at public hearings and for consideration by the Board at future meetings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent or his designee shall be authorized to take any additional acts needed to effectuate the purpose and intent of this resolution.
