Student Board Representative Caelyn Smith provided a report of the activities and events occurring at the district's high schools.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Superintendent Greg Plutko opened his comments by thanking Student Board Member Caelyn Smith for her efforts and preparation for the Board meeting.

Dr. Plutko noted that this last week was a wonderful week for our district highlighted by several notable events. First, on Wednesday night was the 43<sup>rd</sup> Annual District Band Pageant. He is appreciative and proud of all the hard work by everyone to put on such an exceptional event. Second, Esperanza High School finished their WASC visitation and received a glowing report from the exiting committee. Last, El Dorado High School's annual Veterans Day Memorial was a very special and touching tradition.

Last week began the second year of the Thankful for PYL Teachers campaign highlighting different teachers in our district. The campaign expressed how thankful we are for all they do for our students.

Golden Elementary was recognized as a 2018 National Blue Ribbon School in a ceremony in Washington, DC, this past week. Deputy Superintendent Mrs. Candy Plahy was in Washington, DC, with the school site team and shared reflections of her time there. She said it was an honor to be there representing Golden Elementary School and that it was insightful sharing and networking with other districts in other states.

Dr. Plutko remarked on the importance of partnerships with people in our community. He mentioned how thankful the district is for our partnership with the Placentia Library District and spoke of the remodel of the library, which is a central part of community. Dr. Plutko presented a slideshow with pictures of architect renditions of the library, which is still open during the remodel. Dr. Plutko thanked Director Jeanette Contreras for our continued partnership with the library and mentioned there will be a ribbon cutting ceremony in September 2019.

Yorba Linda High School is celebrating the school's 10-year anniversary. Associated Student Body President Lauren Bui spoke on behalf of the school and thanked everyone for their support while YLHS student representatives handed each Board member a 10-year anniversary coin. Ms. Bui extended an invitation to attend their 10-year anniversary celebration on December 10. Dr. Plutko expressed his appreciation for YLHS Principal Dave Flynn.

Lastly, Dr. Plutko congratulated Board Trustees Karin Freeman and Carrie Buck who ran unopposed in their trustee areas in the November election. He shared that this is definitely a compliment to the community's trust in our Board of Education.

**RESOLUTION NO. 13**

**OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT  
GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT AN EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) TO CITY OF  
ANAHEIM**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Anaheim (“City”) has requested that the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (“School District”) dedicate an easement to City of Anaheim upon a portion of the School District’s Esperanza High School site (“Easement”). A legal description and map depicting the location of the Easement is attached hereto as Exhibit “A, B & C” and incorporated herein;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17556, the governing board of a school district may convey to any public corporation, or private corporation engaged in the public utility business, any real property belonging to such school district upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree;

**WHEREAS**, the School District desires to provide an Easement to City of Anaheim for public utility for electrical purposes to construct, reconstruct, install, replace, reconfigure, operate, maintain, repair, relocate, remove, inspect, observe, and study the equipment, and related appurtenances in, on, over, under, upon, above, along and across the land in the City of Anaheim on Esperanza High School;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must, prior to dedicating an Easement, adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate such Easement in a regular open meeting by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all of its members;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must fix a time at its regular place of meeting for a public hearing upon the question of making the dedication of the Easement; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17558, the School District is required to post copies of this Resolution, signed by the board, in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries not less than ten (10) days before the public hearing, and publish notice once, not less than five (5) days before the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the School District, if there is one, or, if there is no such newspaper published in the School District, then in a newspaper published in the county which has a general circulation in the School District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the above recitals are all true and correct.

**Section 2.** That the School District’s governing board (“Board”) declares its intent to dedicate the Easement to City of Anaheim upon the terms and conditions set forth in the recitals.

**Section 3.** That the Board establishes December 11, 2018 for a public hearing on the question of the School District’s intent to dedicate the Easement to City of Anaheim.

**Section 4.** The School District staff shall post this resolution in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries and publish notice of the adoption of this Resolution in compliance with Education Code Section 17558.





The District's Superintendent or designee is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate any further changes, insertions, and omissions to the Energy Efficiency Agreement as are reasonably deemed necessary, and thereafter to execute and deliver the Energy Efficiency Agreement following the Board's adoption of this Resolution. The District's Superintendent or designee is further authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all papers, instruments, opinions, certificates, affidavits, and other documents and to do or cause to be done any and all other acts and things necessary or proper for carrying out this Resolution and said Agreement.
5. The Project is hereby found to be exempt from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to the Class 1, Class 2, Class 3, Class 11 and Class 14 Exemptions, as described above.

6. District staff are hereby authorized and directed to file and process a Notice of CEQA Exemption for the Project in accordance with CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines, and the findings set forth in this Resolution.

**RESOLUTION NO. 14**

**RESOLUTION MAKING FINDINGS ON ENERGY SAVINGS  
AND DETERMINING OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION WITH  
ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, it is the policy of the State of California and the intent of the State Legislature to promote all feasible means of energy conservation and all feasible uses of alternative energy supply sources; and

**WHEREAS**, Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District ("District") desires to reduce the steadily rising costs of meeting the energy needs at its facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, TerraVerde Renewable Partners, LLC ("TerraVerde"), has provided the District with analysis showing the benefits of implementing certain energy conservation measures, and TerraVerde's analysis ("Analysis") is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made part hereof by this reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the District proposes to enter into an energy services agreement and related contract documents ("Energy Efficiency Agreement") with **Giannelli Electric** ("Contractor"), pursuant to which Contractor will install and implement on District property certain energy saving improvements, including upgrades and modifications to lighting systems and other energy conservation and efficiency measures which will result in greater energy efficiency and cost savings for the District sites on which such improvements and measures are located ("Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the sites where such energy saving improvements will be located are: Brookhaven Elementary, Fairmont Elementary, Glenknoll Elementary, Glenview Elementary, Bernardo Yorba Middle, Tuffree Middle, Yorba Linda Middle, El Camino High, and Esperanza (West Campus) High schools, and other sites to be determined by the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Analysis includes data showing that the anticipated cost to the District for the conservation services provided by the Project will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the District of electrical energy that would have been consumed by the District in the absence of those purchases; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education ("Board") proposes to enter into the Energy Efficiency Agreement substantially in the form presented at this meeting, subject to such changes, insertions, or omissions as the Superintendent or other designee reasonably deems necessary following the Board's adoption of this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code Section 4217.12, the Board has held a public hearing, public notice of which was given at least two weeks in advance, to receive public comment; and

**WHEREAS**, the District's proposed approval of the Energy Efficiency Agreement is a project for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Guidelines for CEQA, California Code of Regulations Title 14, Chapter 13 ("State CEQA Guidelines"), exempt certain projects from further CEQA evaluation, including the

following: (1) projects consisting of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing use ("Class 1 Exemption"; Cal. Code Regs., Tit. 14, § 15301); (2) projects consisting of replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced ("Class 2 Exemption"; Cal. Code Regs., Tit. 14, § 15302); (3) projects consisting of the new construction or conversion of small structures ("Class 3 Exemption"; Cal. Code Regs., Tit. 14, § 15303); (4) projects consisting of the construction or placement of minor accessory structures to existing facilities ("Class 11 Exemption"; Cal. Code Regs., Tit. 14, § 15311); and (5) projects consisting of minor additions to existing schools ("Class 14 Exemption"; Cal. Code Regs., Tit. 14, § 15314), and the Project is categorically exempt under one or more of such exemptions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project does not involve any of the following and so is eligible for a categorical exemption as described above under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2:

- (a) the cumulative impact of successive projects of the same type in the same place, which over time are significant;
- (b) an activity where there is a reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances;
- (c) a project which may result in damage to scenic resources, including but not limited to, trees, historic buildings, rock outcroppings, or similar resources, within a highway officially designated as a state scenic highway;
- (d) a hazardous waste site which is included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code; and
- (e) a project which may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, based upon the above-referenced recitals, the Board hereby finds, determines and orders as follows:

1. The Board finds that terms of the Energy Efficiency Agreement in the form presented at this meeting are in the best interests of the District.
2. In accordance with Government Code Section 4217.12 and based on data provided by the Analysis, the Board finds that the anticipated cost to the District for the conservation services provided by the Project will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the District of electrical energy that would have been consumed by the District in the absence of those purchases.
3. The Board hereby approves the Energy Efficiency Agreement, which shall be subject to such changes, insertions, or omissions as the District's Superintendent or designee reasonably deems necessary.
4. The District's Superintendent or designee is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate any further changes, insertions, and omissions to the Energy Efficiency Agreement as are reasonably deemed necessary, and thereafter to execute and deliver the Energy Efficiency Agreement following the Board's adoption of this Resolution. The District's Superintendent or designee is further authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all papers, instruments, opinions, certificates, affidavits, and other documents and to do or cause to be done any and all other acts and things necessary or proper for carrying out this Resolution and said Agreement.

5. The Project is hereby found to be exempt from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to the Class 1, Class 2, Class 3, Class 11 and Class 14 Exemptions, as described above.

6. District staff are hereby authorized and directed to file and process a Notice of CEQA Exemption for the Project in accordance with CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines, and the findings set forth in this Resolution.


