**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Superintendent Greg Plutko opened the meeting by commenting on what an exciting time the start of school is and thanked our PLY families for such a smooth start. As school started, Dr. Plutko and Deputy Superintendent Candy Plahy were able to visit almost every campus and check in with everyone. It was wonderful to see the energy, engagement, and connection of the students to their schools and the district, which is what makes this time so special.

Dr. Plutko shared that this evening Assistant Superintendent David Giordano would speak about our Unaudited Actuals, which are mandated to be presented before September 15. We are pleased with our budget, but we are just above the minimum reserve, which is not uncommon in California. Our budget is in a manageable position, as Mr. Giordano will share in his presentation.

Superintendent Plutko thanked Jim Drummond for his article in our local news entitled, *Placentia-Yorba Linda shows score improvements with AP and International Baccalaureate programs*. Dr. Plutko expressed that he is most proud of this because it means more tests are being given, which equates to more access and opportunity for our students and more students are being challenged with the rigor of those programs. Our IB program is one of the premiere programs in all of southern California when you look at total number and passage rates and this translates to all of our teachers, all the way down to our elementary schools and certainly middle schools preparing them for high school.

**BOARD REPORT**

Mrs. Karin Freeman commented that since school started, she is trying to visit every school and is almost there. It is nice to go in and have a conversation with the front office staff. She attended an assembly at Van Buren on school rules, saw the beginning of the year vocal and instrument assembly at Tynes, and observed Playworks in action at Rio Vista. She went to the bell game, which was a good game if you were from Valencia. She was very impressed by the spirit and good sportsmanship of our students. Lastly, she attended a back-to-school night at Linda Vista.

Mrs. Judi Carmona shared that she has been planning for the Annual Tee It Up for the Troops Golf Tournament at Alta Vista to raise funds to support veteran organizations and active duty military. The event was enormously successful, and she was extremely proud of the presentation of colors by our Air Force Junior ROTC students. They were so sharp, and it was good to have Principal Gina Aguilar and Assistant Principal Scott Mazurier there to celebrate and support them.

RESOLUTION NO. 4  
September 11, 2018

WHEREAS, in November of 1979, the California electorate did adopt Proposition 4, commonly called the Gann Amendment, which added Article XIII-B to the California Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, the provisions of that Article establish maximum appropriation limitations, commonly called "Gann Limits," for public agencies, including school districts; and,

WHEREAS, the District must establish a revised Gann limit for the 2017-18 fiscal year and a projected Gann Limit for the 2018-19 fiscal year in accordance with the provisions of Article XIII-B and applicable statutory law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board does provide public notice that the attached calculations and documentation of the Gann limits for the 2017-18 and 2018-19 fiscal years are made in accord with applicable constitutional and statutory law;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board does hereby declare that the appropriations in the Budget for the 2017-18 and 2018-19 fiscal years do not exceed the limitations imposed by Proposition 4;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent provides copies of this resolution along with the appropriate attachments to interested citizens of this district.

The actual appropriations limit for 2017-18 was \$166,024,604 and the appropriations did not exceed the limitations imposed by Article XIII-B of the California Constitution.

The appropriations limit for 2018-19 is estimated to be \$171,601,354 and the appropriations do not exceed the limitations imposed by Article XIII-B of the California Constitution.

**RESOLUTION NO. 5  
OF THE PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD  
DETERMINING STEPS TO ENSURE AVAILABILITY OF TEXTBOOKS AND INSTRUCTIONAL  
MATERIALS FOR 2018 – 2019**

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 60119 establishes steps and procedures to ensure the availability of textbooks and instructional materials in order to be eligible to receive funds for that purpose, and;

WHEREAS, the procedures require that school districts take appropriate action to ensure the availability of textbooks and instructional materials on a yearly basis, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Sections 60119 and 60422(b), the Board is required to hold a public hearing to encourage participation by parents, teachers, members of the community interested in the affairs of the school district, and bargaining unit leaders, and;

WHEREAS, the Board is required to provide ten days' notice of the public hearing or hearings, and;

WHEREAS, the notice shall contain the time, place, and purpose of the hearing and be posted in three public places within the school district, and;

WHEREAS, the hearing shall be held at a time that will encourage the attendance of teachers and parents and guardians of pupils who attend the schools in the district and shall not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of a school district, as part of the required hearing, shall also make a written determination as to whether each pupil enrolled in a foreign language, or health course has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board for those subjects, and;

WHEREAS, the Governing Board shall also determine the availability of laboratory science equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 – 12, inclusive, and;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on September 11, 2018, and;

WHEREAS, the Board is required to make a determination as to whether each pupil in each school in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board:

- (i) Mathematics
- (ii) Science
- (iii) History-social science
- (iv) English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program
- (v) Visual and performing arts

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board makes the determination that each pupil of the district, has available sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board and adopted by this Board in accordance with the procedures as established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2018 – 2019 school year, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District will provide each pupil with sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board for those subjects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2018 – 2019 school year, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District will provide sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board, to each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course and that sufficient laboratory science equipment applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 – 12, inclusive, is available to pupils.

**WHEREAS**, research shows great schools are led by great principals, and great districts are led by great superintendents. These site leaders are supported by extensive administrative networks throughout the state; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California has declared the second full week of October as the “Week of the School Administrator” in Education Code 44015.1; and

**WHEREAS**, the future of California’s public education system depends upon the quality of its leadership;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District, that all school leaders be commended for the contributions they make to successful student achievement.


