Student Board Representative Nicholas Fiore provided a report of the activities and events occurring at the district's high schools.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Dr. Plutko opened his report by thanking Student Board Representative Nic Fiore for his work and praised him for being a reflection of those he gives credit to.

Tonight was amazing as we learned about the accomplishments of our students. Superintendent Plutko said we should sell stock in kids because they will do amazing things. He thanked everyone for their contribution to such a wonderful recognition presentation.

### **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT (Continued)**

Dr. Plutko asked Deputy Superintendent Candy Plahy to speak about our LCAP process and to update the Board as to where we are in the process. Deputy Superintendent Plahy then presented the draft of the 2018-19, year 2 of the 3-year, LCAP document. At the conclusion of her presentation, she thanked those that worked so hard to put together such a stellar document. Dr. Plutko then thanked Mrs. Plahy and mentioned that she is known for her leadership at the county level.

Superintendent Plutko announced that two of our elementary schools were recently named 2018 California Distinguished Schools, the state's top honor for campuses. He congratulated Glenknoll Elementary School in Yorba Linda and Golden Elementary School in Placentia for receiving this award. The schools and their principals will be officially honored in May during an awards ceremony.

Testing season is upon us, and Dr. Plutko thanked clerical, teachers, and administrators for all the work that goes into having an efficient and streamlined testing system. In the state of California, we will be measured and scores will be published. He is proud of all the work that is being done.

As you know, the State of California recently passed a law that all school districts must test water with their water municipalities for levels of lead. We were one of the first districts to immediately step up to the task for the safety and wellness of our kids. Our Maintenance and Facilities team deserves credit for working with our four water municipalities and completing testing in a three-week period. Dr. Plutko is proud to report that all tests have met the requirements of the law in the State of California and he wanted to thank Mr. Giordano and his team for all their outstanding work. We will be sending a follow-up letter to our entire school community as well as the water districts.

Lastly, we are at the march to the graduation steps, which was very apparent tonight with the clanging of award medals. It is time for elementary teachers to realize the amazing accomplishments as they have seen their students grow so much, our middle school teachers who have helped their students in so many ways to transition to that next big world, and our high school teachers stand there with that sense of pride as their student's walk across the stage. Dr. Plutko thanked teachers, classified staff, and administrators for all the work, including late nights and early mornings, and those extra conversations so that our kids know that the PYL has a unique and special belonging space for all of them. He is very proud to share this information.

**BOARD REPORT**

Mrs. Karin Freeman shared that retired former Mayor of Yorba Linda, Gene Wisner, passed away. She mentioned that she had the thrill of attending the outstanding program, *Prism*, at El Dorado, and this year it was exceptional with incredible talent display and performances. We had the day of March 14 where students across America chose to exercise the opportunity to express themselves pertaining to the Stoneman Douglas High School incident. Mrs. Freeman chose to go to Esperanza High School to see what was happening, and it was a very positive few minutes that the students gathered in quad. At the end, they handed out a paper entitled "*What is Your 17?*" which gave seventeen reasons to make a difference. She shared this paper with the Board and mentioned that this was an excellent example of positive critical thinking. We should be pleased and hopeful for the future. Mrs. Freeman thanked everyone for the Principal for a Day event and expressed that it was a positive experience and an excellent opportunity to hear and see what is going on – with technology as well as with the interaction with students. Lastly, she noted that 1,664 paperback dictionaries to be distributed to our third-grade students were donated by the Fullerton Elks Club.

Mr. Eric Padget shared an article in *High School Today* regarding considering the cost before cutting athletic programs. He wanted to reiterate that the Board is very proud of the accomplishments of our students in this district and congratulated the teachers and students that were recognized tonight. She works with the Placentia Collaborative, St. Jude, the American Heart Association, and many other agencies in the city and the county to ensure our kids are healthy.

Mrs. Carol Downey went to Principal for a Day luncheon, which was very enjoyable. Mrs. Downey was also able to attend the R.E.A.C.H. Foundation's 5K run in March. There were many people there, and the weather was just right for a run. She is looking forward to the high school distinguished scholars and senior awards nights.

**RESOLUTION NO. 29**

**RESOLUTION MAKING FINDINGS ON ENERGY SAVINGS  
AND DETERMINING OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION WITH  
ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, it is the policy of the State of California and the intent of the State Legislature to promote all feasible means of energy conservation and all feasible uses of alternative energy supply sources; and

**WHEREAS**, Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District ("District") desires to reduce the steadily rising costs of meeting the energy needs at its facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, TerraVerde Energy, LLC ("TerraVerde"), has provided the District with analysis showing the benefits of implementing certain energy conservation measures, and TerraVerde's analysis ("Analysis") is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made part hereof by this reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the District proposes to enter into an energy services agreement and related contract documents ("Energy Efficiency Agreement") with **Giannelli Electric** ("Contractor"), pursuant to which Contractor will install and implement on District property certain energy saving improvements, including upgrades and modifications to HVAC systems and other energy conservation and efficiency measures which will result in greater energy efficiency and cost savings for the District sites on which such improvements and measures are located ("Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the sites where such energy saving improvements will be located are: at various sites throughout the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Analysis includes data showing that the anticipated cost to the District for the conservation services provided by the Project will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the District of electrical energy that would have been consumed by the District in the absence of those purchases; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education ("Board") proposes to enter into the Energy Efficiency Agreement substantially in the form presented at this meeting, subject to such changes, insertions or omissions as the Superintendent or other designee reasonably deems necessary following the Board's adoption of this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code Section 4217.12, the Board has held a public hearing, public notice of which was given at least two weeks in advance, to receive public comment; and

**WHEREAS**, the District's proposed approval of the Energy Efficiency Agreement is a project for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Guidelines for CEQA, California Code of Regulations Title 14, Chapter 13 (“State CEQA Guidelines”), exempt certain projects from further CEQA evaluation, including the following: (1) projects consisting of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing use (“Class 1 Exemption”; Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15301); (2) projects consisting of replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced (“Class 2 Exemption”; Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15302); (3) projects consisting of the new construction or conversion of small structures (“Class 3 Exemption”; Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15303); (4) projects consisting of the construction or placement of minor accessory structures to existing facilities (“Class 11 Exemption”; Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15311); and (5) projects consisting of minor additions to existing schools (“Class 14 Exemption”; Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15314), and the Project is categorically exempt under one or more of such exemptions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project does not involve any of the following and so is eligible for a categorical exemption as described above under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2:

- (a) the cumulative impact of successive projects of the same type in the same place, which over time are significant;
- (b) an activity where there is a reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances;
- (c) a project which may result in damage to scenic resources, including but not limited to, trees, historic buildings, rock outcroppings, or similar resources, within a highway officially designated as a state scenic highway;
- (d) a hazardous waste site which is included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code; and
- (e) a project which may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, based upon the above-referenced recitals, the Board hereby finds, determines and orders as follows:

1. The Board finds that terms of the Energy Efficiency Agreement in the form presented at this meeting are in the best interests of the District.
2. In accordance with Government Code Section 4217.12, and based on data provided by the Analysis, the Board finds that the anticipated cost to the District for the conservation services provided by the Project will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the District of electrical energy that would have been consumed by the District in the absence of those purchases.
3. The Board hereby approves the Energy Efficiency Agreement, which shall be subject to such changes, insertions or omissions as the District’s Superintendent or designee reasonably deems necessary.

4. The District’s Superintendent or designee is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate any further changes, insertions and omissions to the Energy Efficiency Agreement as are reasonably deemed necessary, and thereafter to execute and deliver the Energy Efficiency Agreement following the Board’s adoption of this Resolution. The District’s Superintendent or designee is further authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all papers, instruments, opinions, certificates, affidavits, and other documents and to do or cause to be done any and all other acts and things necessary or proper for carrying out this Resolution and said Agreement.

5. The Project is hereby found to be exempt from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to the Class 1, Class 2, Class 3, Class 11 and Class 14 Exemptions, as described above.

6. District staff are hereby authorized and directed to file and process a Notice of CEQA Exemption for the Project in accordance with CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines, and the findings set forth in this Resolution.


