STUDENT BOARD REPORT

Student Board Member Noah Campuzano provided a report of the activities and events occurring at the district's high schools.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Greg Plutko commented on Student Board Member Noah Campuzano's great response to the question the Board posed to him. He assured Noah that teachers are working hard and participating in professional development to be prepared when school begins.

We know that the return to school and how it will be done is the subject on everyone's mind. At this time, we are moving forward with remote learning as we are on the state monitoring list. We know the best scenario would be to have teachers and kids together; and even trying to achieve that, our focus must be on wellness. The monitoring list date is challenging but we continue to watch it closely. Elementary waivers are an option but at this time no public school in Orange County has turned in a waiver.

Dr. Plutko indicated that tomorrow we would have the final data from the Hanover survey regarding distance learning. Of the 11,000 responses the top two concerns were student engagement and quality of instruction centering around student wellness. Once we are off the monitoring list, we will initiate a more detailed survey.

The Superintendent thanked the Board of Trustees for adopting the resolution condemning racism at the August 11, 2020 Board Meeting. As part of the resolution, a follow-up committee of staff and families is being formed. The chairperson for this committee is Valadez Principal Cuco Gracian and the first meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 19. Mr. Gracian is very excited about this leadership opportunity.

Lastly, Dr. Plutko gave a reminder that due to the COVID crisis the Local Control and Accountability Plan due date was pushed to September 30, 2020. A public hearing will be held at the September 8, 2020 Board Meeting and a single-item Special Board Meeting will be held either September 23 or 24. Once the date is confirmed, it will be published for the community on the District website.

BOARD REPORT

Mrs. Judi Carmona reported that she was excited to see the professionalism of staff as they successfully navigate the distance-learning platform. She stated that we have an incredible team and looks forward to seeing the professional development and how teachers will creatively manage this different type of education for our students.

Mrs. Carrie Buck reported that Bella, the middle school student who experienced COVID with significant issues, is doing well now. Bella is making masks as a fundraiser, and Mrs. Buck brought each of the Board members one of Bella’s masks. As she drove by Rose Drive Elementary, Trustee Buck noticed some girls with an ice cream stand and stopped to talk with them. They use the money they collect to buy food for kids in our district that need it. She also stopped to see the food distribution at Valencia High School and noted how many families were in line to take advantage of this much-needed service. Mrs. Buck is impressed with all the work that staff is doing to get ready for the first day of school, and she is excited but apprehensive to start the new year.

Mrs. Carol Downey thanked staff for all of the time and effort to get ready for the fall during these trying times. She commented how wonderful the food distribution is and thanked everyone for the hard work and time spent to help serve the families in our community that need that assistance. Mrs. Downey shared her that her daughter is a nurse and has indicated that COVID-19 is one of the worst viruses she has seen. It is important for us to remember the safety and wellness of everyone in our return to school plans.

Mrs. Karin Freeman thanked staff for the all of their amazing work, for example, the detailed bell schedules for remote learning shared with the Board. Mrs. Freeman will be participating in the ROP virtual meeting tomorrow where they will discuss the COVID plan for this year. Recently, she had the opportunity to attend the grand opening for the Placentia Veterans Village, a community for homeless veterans offering housing, financial, and health assistance. Donations may be made through their website. In looking at ways we can assist our families that work best for them, Parkview School is a bonus as it provides assistance with home schooling for those who prefer this form of education. Mrs. Freeman asked Student Board Member Noah Campuzano to let the Board know if he hears of unique ways that students find to address that disconnected sense and get back to school spirit and wellness. She closed by thanking everyone who attends the Board meetings for honoring the request to wear face masks as there are some people who have health risks and the added protection means everything to them.

Mr. Eric Padget commented that Student Board Member Noah Campuzano said it best that it is hard to teach and learn remotely, and he hopes it works well for everyone. Mr. Padget expressed that in thinking about the return to school, our biggest concern is for the safety of staff, students, and families. We need to plan for return to school very thoughtfully. Mr. Padget commented that we will get more information on the waiver process for elementary. Children are uniquely different, and we have programs that should support everyone.

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-08
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL
DISTRICT GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT AN EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) TO CITY
OF YORBA LINDA**

WHEREAS, the City of Yorba Linda (“City”) has requested that the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (“School District”) dedicate an easement to City of Yorba Linda upon a portion of the School District’s Yorba Linda High School site (“Easement”). A legal description and map depicting the location of the Easement is attached hereto as Exhibit “A and B” and incorporated herein;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17556, the governing board of a school district may convey to any public corporation, or private corporation engaged in the public utility business, any real property belonging to such school district upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree;

WHEREAS, the School District desires to provide an Easement to City of Yorba Linda for landscape maintenance, on, over, under, upon, above, along, and across the land in the City of Yorba Linda on Yorba Linda High School;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must, prior to dedicating an Easement, adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate such Easement in a regular open meeting by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all of its members;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must fix a time at its regular place of meeting for a public hearing upon the question of making the dedication of the Easement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17558, the School District is required to post copies of this Resolution, signed by the board, in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries not less than ten (10) days before the public hearing, and publish notice once, not less than five (5) days before the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the School District, if there is one, or, if there is no such newspaper published in the School District, then in a newspaper published in the county which has a general circulation in the School District.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1.** That the above recitals are all true and correct.
- Section 2.** That the School District’s governing board (“Board”) declares its intent to dedicate the Easement to City of Yorba Linda upon the terms and conditions set forth in the recitals.
- Section 3.** That the Board establishes September 8, 2020 for a public hearing on the question of the School District’s intent to dedicate the Easement to City of Yorba Linda.
- Section 4.** The School District staff shall post this resolution in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries and publish notice of the adoption of this resolution in compliance with Education Code Section 17558.





**RESOLUTION NO. 20-09
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL
DISTRICT GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT AN EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) TO CITY
OF YORBA LINDA**

WHEREAS, the City of Yorba Linda (“City”) has requested that the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (“School District”) dedicate an easement to City of Yorba Linda upon a portion of the School District’s Yorba Linda High School site (“Easement”). A legal description and map depicting the location of the Easement is attached hereto as Exhibit “A and B” and incorporated herein;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17556, the governing board of a school district may convey to any public corporation, or private corporation engaged in the public utility business, any real property belonging to such school district upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree;

WHEREAS, the School District desires to provide an Easement to City of Yorba Linda for an installation of a traffic signal, on, over, under, upon, above, along, and across the land in the City of Yorba Linda on Yorba Linda High School;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must, prior to dedicating an Easement, adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate such Easement in a regular open meeting by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all of its members;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must fix a time at its regular place of meeting for a public hearing upon the question of making the dedication of the Easement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 17558, the School District is required to post copies of this Resolution, signed by the board, in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries not less than ten (10) days before the public hearing, and publish notice once, not less than five (5) days before the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the School District, if there is one, or, if there is no such newspaper published in the School District, then in a newspaper published in the county which has a general circulation in the School District.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1.** That the above recitals are all true and correct.
- Section 2.** That the School District’s governing board (“Board”) declares its intent to dedicate the Easement to City of Yorba Linda upon the terms and conditions set forth in the recitals.
- Section 3.** That the Board establishes September 8, 2020 for a public hearing on the question of the School District’s intent to dedicate the Easement to City of Yorba Linda.
- Section 4.** The School District staff shall post this resolution in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries and publish notice of the adoption of this resolution in compliance with Education Code Section 17558.



RESOLUTION NO. 20-07 OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
August 11, 2020

WHEREAS, the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (the "District") desires to request the County Treasurer to make temporary transfers (the "Transfer") of monies to meet its current maintenance expenses for fiscal years 2020-2021 and 2021-2022; and

WHEREAS, California Constitution Article XVI, Section 6, provides that the County Treasurer shall have the power and the duty to make temporary transfers of monies, as further specified therein, upon resolution adopted by the Board of Supervisors authorizing such temporary transfer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Constitution Article XVI, Section 6 and Education Code Section 42620, the total amount that may be temporarily transferred to the District may not exceed 85% of the anticipated revenues which will accrue to the District during the fiscal year ("FY"); and

WHEREAS, the District has not issued, nor will issue, a Tax Revenue Anticipation Note ("TRAN") or other borrowing of any kind or nature for the purpose of funding the District's short-term cash flow, which is outstanding in whole or in part, while a Transfer is outstanding; and

WHEREAS, any Transfer to the District will be made from and limited to the total funds on deposit with the County Treasurer for all of the Orange County school and community college districts, excluding debt service and bond project funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the District FINDS, DECLARES, RESOLVES, and ORDERS as follows:

1. The Transfer is in the public interest and serves a valid public purpose.
2. That a transfer of monies from the total funds on deposit with the County Treasurer for all of the Orange County school and community college districts be made to the District to cover the District's current maintenance expenses for FY 2020-2021 and FY 2021-2022. The amount of any Transfer shall not exceed 85% of the anticipated revenues which will accrue to the District during that fiscal year. This amount shall be certified by the District and the actual amount of any Transfer(s) will be approved, if at all, in the discretion of the County Treasurer, exercising her trust and fiduciary duties with respect to protecting the total funds on deposit with the County Treasurer for all of the Orange County school and community college districts from any principal loss and ensuring adequate liquidity to meet operating cash needs, and ensuring that such monies are available for such Transfers. The District Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed for and on behalf of the District to formally request a Transfer in an amount and upon a date designated by the Superintendent, not to exceed the limitations to such Transfer as provided herein.
3. That for FY 2020-2021, the Transfer be made by the County Treasurer in one or more installments and not prior to July 1, 2020, nor later than April 26, 2021. The Transfer shall be repaid no later than October 31, 2021.
4. That for FY 2021-2022, the Transfer be made by the County Treasurer in one or more installments and not prior to July 1, 2021, nor later than April 25, 2022. The Transfer shall be repaid no later than October 31, 2022.

DISTANCE LEARNING

The Governing Board recognizes that distance learning can be a viable alternative instructional strategy that supports student achievement of academic goals. Distance learning opportunities may be offered to students participating in independent study, credit recovery courses, enrichment courses, or other courses identified by the Superintendent or designee, or in the event that a school site is physically closed due to widespread illness, natural disaster, or other emergency.

The District may offer distance learning through a variety of delivery methods as appropriate for the grade level and subject matter. Distance learning opportunities may include video, audio, and/or written instruction in which the primary mode of communication between the student and teacher is online interaction, instructional television, live or prerecorded video, telecourses, and other instruction that relies on computer or communications technology. They may also include the use of print materials with written or oral feedback.

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NUMBER OF BOARD MEMBERS AND TERM OF OFFICE

Number

The Board of Education of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District is composed of five members elected by-trustee area by the qualified voters of the district as their non-partisan representatives on school matters.

In addition, one student shall be appointed to the Board as a member with a preferential vote. The student board member’s vote shall not affect the final numerical outcome of a vote but shall be recorded in the minutes of the Board meeting. The student selected to serve shall be enrolled in a district high school and shall be an elected or appointed Associated Student Body officer/member. The student member shall have the right and responsibility to attend all meetings of the Board of Education except closed sessions.

Term of Office

Each person elected to the Board of Education at the regular biennial election shall hold office for a term of four years, commencing on the second Friday in December following their election. A member whose term has expired shall continue to discharge the duties of the office until his/her successor has qualified by taking the oath of office.

The terms of Board members shall be staggered so that approximately half of the Board, i.e., either two or three members, shall be elected in each even-numbered year.

The student board member shall serve a one semester term commencing on the first Board meeting in July for the first semester term and on the first Board meeting in January for the second semester term.

GOVERNING BOARD ELECTIONS

An election for members of the Board of Education of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District shall be held biennially on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each succeeding even-numbered year to fill the offices of those members whose terms expire on the first Friday in December following the election. A member whose term has expired shall continue to discharge the duties of the office until his/her successor has qualified by taking the oath of office.

The regular biennial election of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District shall be consolidated with that of the North Orange County Community College District, and may be further consolidated with city elections in accordance with provisions of the Education Code and the Elections Code. Such consolidations shall be effected by the County Superintendent of Schools, County of Orange, upon receipt of the Board's written resolution requesting such consolidations, and with the written consent of the affected city's legislative body and that of the North Orange County Community College District's Board of Trustees when consolidation with city elections is requested.

The Board's written resolution(s), the specifications of the election order, shall be delivered to the County Superintendent not less than 123 days prior to the day of the election. The date of the election and the purpose of the election shall be stated therein, as shall the authority for ordering the election and the authority for the specifications of the election order, and the signature of the Clerk of the Board shall be affixed thereto.

Persons seeking to be named as candidates or to nominate a candidate for election to the Board must file with the Registrar of Voters, County of Orange, a declaration of candidacy or a nomination by sponsors not more than 113 days nor less than 88 days prior to the election in order to be named, or to name, a candidate on the ballot.

The regular biennial election of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District shall be governed by the Elections Code, except as otherwise provided in the Education Code.

Board Member Qualifications

Any person is eligible to be a member of the Governing Board, without further qualifications, if he/she is:

- 18 years of age or older by election day,
- a citizen of California,
- a resident of the school district,
- a resident of the trustee area for the office he/she is seeking,
- a registered voter at the time Nomination Papers are issued and qualified to vote for the office,
- eligible to take the oath of office and be able to be bonded in the amounts provided for by statute,

- not an employee of a school district at the time sworn into office as an elected or appointed member of that school district's governing board,
- not legally disqualified by the Constitution or laws of the State from holding civil office.

A district employee elected to the Board shall resign his/her employment before being sworn in or shall have his/her employment automatically terminated upon being sworn into office.

Elections Process and Procedures

The district is divided into by-trustee areas and each trustee area shall be represented by one Board member who resides in and is elected by voters residing within that trustee area. Trustee areas shall be balanced by population as required by state and federal law.

Prior to March 1 following the year in which the results of each decennial federal census are released, the Board shall adjust the boundaries of the district's trustee areas based on population figures as validated by the Population Research Unit of the Department of Finance.

Campaign Conduct

In order to help protect the public's trust in the electoral process as well as the public's confidence in the Board and district, the Board encourages all candidates to sign and adhere to the principles in the Code of Fair Campaign Practices pursuant to Elections Code 20440.

Statement of Qualifications

The district shall assume no part of the cost of printing, handling, translating, or mailing of candidate statements filed pursuant to Elections Code 13307.

On the 125th day prior to the day fixed for the general district election, the Board secretary or his/her designee shall deliver a notice, bearing the secretary's signature and district seal, to the county elections official describing both of the following:

1. The elective offices of the district to be filled at the general election and which offices, if any, are for the balance of an unexpired term.
2. The candidate is responsible for costs related to the publication of a statement of qualifications.

Candidate statements shall be limited to no more than 200 words.

Tie Votes in Board Member Elections

Whenever a tie makes it impossible to determine which of two or more candidates has been elected to the Board, the Board shall immediately notify the candidates who received the tie votes of the time and place where the candidates or their representatives should appear before the Board. The Board at that time shall determine the winner by lot.


