## **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Superintendent Greg Plutko shared his appreciation for the 2020 Employees of the Year and for their hard work for the families and students of our district.

Dr. Plutko commented that the coronavirus is a big topic and we continue to monitor developments daily. He thanked the district team and lead nurse, Michelle DeHaven, as they continuously work together to share communication with our staff and community regarding updates from the Orange County Health Care Agency. Dr. Plutko invited Executive Director Richard McAlindin to provide a brief update on current coronavirus recommendations from the California Department of Public Health and the Orange County Health Care Agency on how to respond to concerns. The district's communications include a resource hub on our website, preventative measures, above and beyond targeted cleaning at all school campuses and daily cleaning of district buses. Additional preventative measures include added cleaning supplies and hand sanitizer options provided to each school site. We will continue to research and assure that we will pay close attention to the situation.


