She reported that there were 80 students enrolled at USI last year 80 and 133 this year. She attended the Esperanza football game and is excited for theatre to begin this year. She is looking forward to Dr. Kym and the innovative opportunities coming.

Trustee Tricia Quintero thanked the team for all the answers to her email questions submitted to her from parents. She attended the first El Dorado football game as well as back-to-school nights at Topaz and Golden and looks forward to coming back to visit these sites.

Trustee Todd Frazier reiterated that coaches stipends are important as well as good communication to parents re opt out options. Lastly, Mr. Frazier advocated pausing on changes at Parkview and providing better communication.

She stressed that Narcan needs to get out to classrooms and training be provided.

Trustee Marilyn Anderson attended the leadership symposium and the new teacher orientation breakfast. She experienced the welcoming excitement on campus as she walked her grandsons to school their first day and toured classrooms at Melrose ES the same day.
